Buckeye Valley High School Prom/Dance Regulations

1. All dances and prom are for Buckeye Valley High School students. Buckeye Valley students wishing to bring a guest must also comply with the following guidelines:
 - A. Buckeye Valley High School Juniors and Seniors are eligible to attend prom. They can ask a guest to attend if they meet all the other requirements listed.
 - B. All students who wish to bring a guest to prom/dance must have the required permission form completed before purchasing tickets. The form is available in the offices.
 - C. All guests must be either currently in high school or under the age of 21. No middle school or junior high students from any school will be permitted to attend.
 - D. A guest must arrive when the BVHS host student arrives and must leave when the host student leaves.
 - E. Upon the request of school authorities, all guests will submit to drug/alcohol screening, including the use of a portable breathalyzer.
 - F. He or she will NOT sell, purchase, possess, or be under the influence of intoxicants.
 - G. He or she will comply with all school rules, regulations and reasonable requests from school authorities.
 - H. The dance is open only to Buckeye Valley High School students and **one invited guest with approved guest form.**
 - I. A photo I.D. is required of all guests.
 - J. No inappropriate contact or gestures permitted on the dance floor. No “grinding.”
2. Any individuals (BVHS student or their guests) who leave the dance early will not be permitted to return. All guests must also leave when the student who brought them to the dance leaves.
3. The sponsor of the dance may establish additional dress requirements other than those in the student handbook. (Example: formal attire for Prom)
4. All individuals (both students and guests) will abide by all rules and regulations in the Buckeye Valley High School handbook and any other rules established by the sponsor of the dance.
5. Any individuals failing to comply with any rules, regulations, and/or requests of the faculty sponsors may be removed from the dance. No refunds will be given.
6. All rules and regulations also apply to the parking lot areas and automobiles. Being under the influence of and/or testing positive for the use of intoxicants and/or failing to comply with all rule and regulations will result in removal from the event, suspension and/or expulsion from school, and/or legal action.
7. Prom should be considered an elegant, first-class event. Inappropriate suggestive or offensive dancing will not be tolerated. This would include all types of “grinding” and most types of “front to back” dancing. The allowable types of dancing will be at the sole discretion of the chaperones. Students failing to comply will risk having their parents contacted and being sent home with no refund of their ticket purchase.
